Hello,

I wanted to let you know that I have been researching options related to the windows and door storage after being provided with information just yesterday. The request to relocate the windows has not come up until just recently. It is not feasible to have them moved as quickly as tomorrow. I am also still waiting for an inventory and sales receipt dated from the time of order so that I can accurately account for what is being transferred to me. I don't feel it's appropriate to take possession of two crates without knowing exactly what each contains, including the complete and total description and inventory. Please provide me with that information at your earliest convenience.

Regarding the additional funds that were deposited with Yankee Barn Homes:

On 12/2/2021 I paid Yankee Barn Homes an initial \$5,000 deposit. On 4/8/2022 I paid Yankee Barn Homes \$152,810. This totals \$157,810. It is my life savings. This is a horrible situation that will have a lifelong impact on myself and my young daughter. I ask that you show some compassion when trying to work out a fair resolution.

I had every intention of completing the project but as you know, the covid pandemic greatly impacted and changed everything. Historic interest rate hikes, supply issues and the skyrocketing costs that followed were all out of my control. The final blow to our family, causing a delay on the project was receiving multiple diagnoses related to my daughter's health. I was very clear with Yankee Barn Homes about these unexpected challenges. I was told that efforts would be made to transfer the windows and doors to another "Hill House" project. I don't believe anyone ever acted on this. How many other Hill House construction projects were windows ordered for during this time? I attempted to delay the project until Spring of 2026. I was informed by Yankee Barn Homes that other projects have been put on hold for years and that this was possible, which was a false promise and ultimately very damaging to me.

I strongly believe that I have a convincing argument that I should be refunded all of my money due to misleading information from Yankee Barn Homes and a negligent lack of transparent accounting of my funds on deposit as well as misleading representations that things would be worked out fairly and that I could delay the project. I have sufficient proof to support my claims.

I have consulted with the dispute resolution and litigation team at Devine Millimet in NH. I am prepared to move forward on this front and I am confident that I will be successful. As an alternative to litigation, I would like to offer a final proposal. I am asking that in addition to the transfer of windows to me that you release

\$50,000 from the \$157,810 that I have deposited with Yankee Barn Homes. Please let me know if this proposal is satisfactory so I know how to proceed.
