In 2018, the Waterbury Stowe Fish and Game Club will be performing long awaited major maintenance on the rifle range and the skeet fields. This Project has been discussed at our General Membership Meetings and quarterly Board Meeting for a few years.

This Project is different from past projects as the Board and Members see the need to contract some of the work out. Specifically repairing swales and moving that material around the property. Part of this Project is positioning back stop berms behind each target position on the rifle range. Over the last (2) years, in the planning stages of the Project, the Club received estimates between \$6,000 and \$8,000 from local contractors.


