Dear Mr. Cerutti,

My 9 year old daughter came to me with concerns that the batteries were pulled out of the smoke detectors in her home with her father located at 16 Westview St. in Morrisville. My daughter reported they were pulled out quite some time ago when the smoke detectors were going off due to cooking in the kitchen. She reports that the slot is pulled open from the two smoke detectors in the home and has remained this way. I brought this concern to her father by email on 1/27/19 and received no response. My email included a link to the fire code for Multi Family Rental dwellings. I followed up with him on 3/12 and he responded on 3/13 that they had new smoke detectors. My daughter insists that nothing has changed and the detectors look the same as always with batteries pulled out. She reports that she feels unsafe in the home because of this. I followed up with him on 4/2 with these concerns and he did not respond. I do not have the owner contact information. This is a multi family dwelling and his extended family lives in the adjacent apartment where my daughter also spends time. I am concerned for my daughters safety and her father is uncooperative. I am the sole legal custodial parent and I'm hopeful that I can find confirmation that the home where my daughter is sleeping when she is with her father has operational smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and that they are also located where appropriate and hard wired if required. I appreciate your time.
