With the exception of the wrong type of smoke/co alarms (AC/DC) in the rooms all is substantially code compliant. Smoke/co alarms are of the ionization type not the required photoelectric type. Several exit emergency lights inoperative or of the glow in the dark type and need to be repaired or replaced.

#### **Violations and Notes**

Inspection to look at potential renovations for prospective new owners.

The following must be corrected.

- 1. All corridor, stairwell, and storage-mechanical room doors must be self closing and positive latching.
- 2. Guest room smoke alarms were changed in 2017 and were replaced with ionization type alarms. All alarms must be changed to photoelectric type smoke carbon monoxide alarms.
- 3. All exit signs and emergency lights must be operational. Several units were noted to be inoperable.
- 4. Provide hard wired carbon monoxide alarm in the lobby.
- 5. All stairs must have 1-1/4 to 2 inch round handrails on one side. Rails must be mounted 34 to 38 inches above the nosing of the
- 6. The guard rail in the entry lobby, and the second floor rear fire escape must be 42 inches high with balusters spaced less than 4 inches apart.
- 7. The fire alarm must have an annunciation panel installed by the main entry door.
- 8. There was an extension cord noted in the bar area on the lower floor. Extension cords cannot replace the buildings permanent wiring. All cords must be removed and replaced wit an approved wiring method.
- 9. Emergency evacuation plans and instructions must be provided on the inside of all guest room doors.
